With a range of activities to choose from and plenty of space to get outside, your school or group will learn new skills, have fun in nature and create memories that last a lifetime!

Oxenwood Outdoor Education Centre is our primary outdoor learning and activity centre and the most popular choice for school residentials, curriculum enrichment days and on-site adventure activities.

We can offer exclusive access to the Centre and facilities for overnight groups and groups using the classroom.

The Centre is fully equipped for day and residential groups with a catering kitchen, toilet and shower facilities (including disabled access), washing and drying facilities, a main hall, staff room and playing field. We also have a fully equipped classroom, with video and audio equipment.

Oxenwood has a 38 bed capacity in four dormitory rooms for residential bookings. The Centre also has an additional 6-8 bed capacity for group leaders.

Groups can select from fully catered, part catered and self-catered options during their residential visit to Oxenwood. Nutritious, home-cooked food is prepared on the premises each day by our fantastic catering team, with specialist diets





Linkenholt Countryside Adventure Centre

Day Activities and Camping



Linkenholt Countryside Adventure Centre offers high-quality day activities and camping residentials for schools, clubs and groups, all set in 2,000 acres of wide open, varied countryside.

Linkenholt Countryside Adventure Centre is an ideal location for groups who are looking to camp overnight. The Centre 'Base Camp' has ample parking and a large, flat camping area. Schools, clubs and groups can also make use of the main hall for meeting and dining with tables and chairs for up to 50 people, toilet and shower facilities (including disabled access) and kitchen.

Linkenholt Centre is suitable for self-led, independent wildlife, arts, orienteering, team-building, team sports or bushcraft activities. In addition, our team of Outdoor Education Instructors can enrich your group experience through adventure activities e.g. mountain biking, archery and climbing or bespoke Curriculum Enrichment Days.

Linkenholt Centre is a self-catered venue and visiting groups should bring their own cooking supplies or prepared food. The Centre has a fully equipped kitchen with two cookers, microwave, toaster, two kettles and a variety of cooking pots, utensils and crockery.



Join us for a fun-filled day or half-day of adventure activities, led by our qualified and experienced Outdoor Education Instructors. We offer a variety of opportunities to get outside and take part in individual or group adventure activities including water sports, climbing, archery and mountain biking.

All of our adventure activities are centred around teamwork, effective communication and confidence building. Our sessions are suitable for beginners and those with more experience. Contact us to discuss your day or residential trip and we can build a programme of activities for your school or group.

Adventure Activities We offer the following adventure activities:



Archery

Learn to use a bow and arrow on our outdoor archery range. Practise your individual archery skills with support from our trained Instructors and take part in a team competition to put your new archery skills to the test.



Bushcraft/Survival Skills

Survive in the great outdoors by learning how to light and cook on an open fire. Learn how to build a shelter as a group, using sticks, foliage and other materials typically found in woodland and outdoor areas.



Canoeing

Have fun and build confidence on the water. Our multi-person canoes can seat up to four people. Canoeing is a great way to improve communication skills and encourage group-based learning.



Paddlesports

We offer multi-person canoeing, individual kayaking and Stand Up Paddleboard (SUP), so your group can experience a variety of water sports. All of these skills are designed to build confidence on the water.



Raft Building

Raft building is a great team-building activity. Groups of young people or adults work together to design and build a buoyant raft using a selection of materials including barrels, rope and wooden planks.



Kayaking

Kayaking is an individual skill. This activity will help develop independence, decision-making, coordination, and resilience, with games and challenges designed to improve your paddling technique and confidence.



Climbing Wall

Have fun on our climbing wall, test your skills and see if you can climb to the top. This activity develops confidence, strength and endurance. Our climbing wall also has an auto belay for safety and ease of use.



Cycle Skills

Develop your cycling skills in a safe space away from traffic and other hazards. This session will help your group develop confidence on a bicycle, improve independence, develop social skills and boost wellbeing.



Mountain Biking

A guided mountain biking session is an exciting way to explore the outdoors including local trails and routes. Test your skills with varied terrain and develop confidence when cycling off-road, either individually or as a group.



Fencing

Fencing is a great way to develop strategic thinking and confidence. Learn techniques including attack and defence, test your skills by competing against others in your group. The session includes protective clothing and headwear.



Olympic Style Air Rifle

Learn to safely handle and shoot an air rifle with support from Instructors. Develop patience and concentration as you get to grips with an air rifle. Test your skills with target practice in our outdoor range.
